# Music theatre callback information Year 7 entry in 2026

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### What the workshop involves

Your child will take part in a range of activities to assist in the selection process. These may include:

- Dance choreography.
- Singing and performance.
- Your child will need to prepare and memorise the monologue.

### Essential items to bring to the callback

- A bottle of water.
- A copy of the monologue.
- A printed copy of the adjusted conditions approval email (if applicable and only if you have not already provided this)

### On the test day

Upon arrival to John Curtin College of the Arts, locate and follow the signs to the music theatre sign-in desk. Any serious health conditions should be brought to the attention of the staff at this time.

The callback will run for approximately one and a half hours. After the callback, please return to the registration desk to collect and sign out your child.

### Adjusted Conditions

If your child has been approved for adjusted testing conditions, let the sign-in staff know that you have been approved for adjusted conditions and bring a copy of the printed adjusted conditions if not previously provided during the workshop.

### What happens next

If your child is successful in the callback, they will be invited to an interview which are scheduled to take place during Term 2.
