What to film

If you are auditioning on one instrument

1. A short 1-to-2-minute piece on your audition instrument.
2. A second short 1-to-2-minute piece of a contrasting style on your audition instrument.

If you are auditioning on two instruments

1. A short 1-to-2-minute piece on Audition Instrument 1.
2. A short 1-to-2-minute piece on Audition Instrument 2.

How to film checklist

	Instrument is clearly visible
	Applicant is clearly visible
	Video quality is clear
	Sound quality is clear
	Not using a pre-recorded or live accompaniment (some exceptions for voice applications, see the information for voice applicants document)
	Individual videos are no longer than 2 minutes
	Video can be played back on a PC (.mov or .mp4 files are acceptable)
