Application for Residential Place form completed for future years (2021 and beyond)

When you applied for a Residential place at the start 2020 you should've indicated the length of boarding expected over your child's schooling years. i.e Year 7 2020 – Year 12 2025.

The GOOD NEWS is when you provided the College with this information, you are not required to reapply each year. The signed Boarding agreement is in place for the duration that the student is at schooling.

So for 2021 and beyond there is NO requirement to repeat this process.

However, we would appreciate if you could contact the College either by phone or email to advise if your child is not returning or if you change contact details. The College requires two weeks notice if you decide at any stage that your child will not be returning. If we do not hear from you and you have a signed agreement, we will expect your child is returning in 2021.

Around the College Tutoring

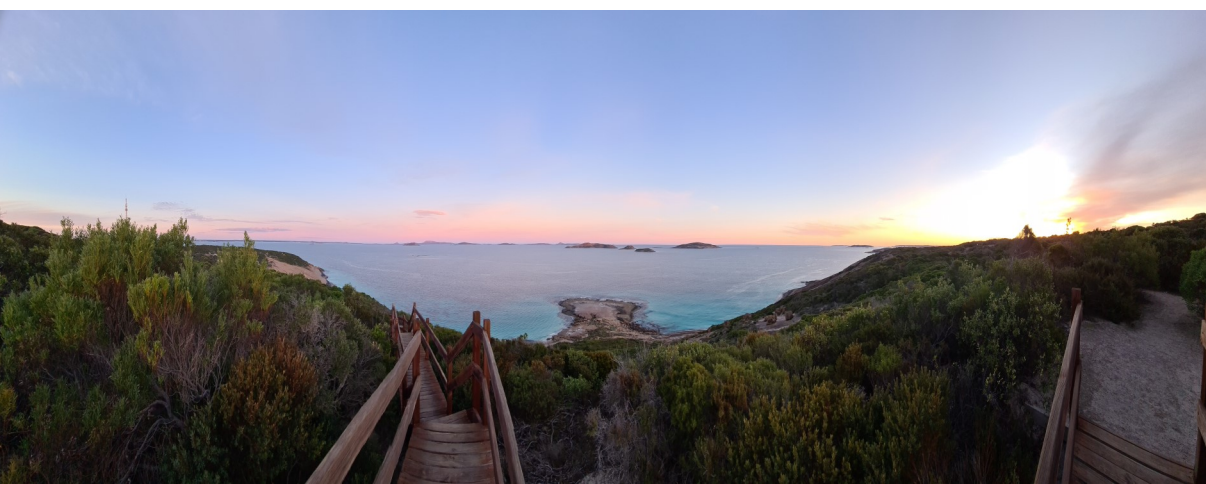
