

Nationally Coordinated Criminal History Check Identification requirements

You must provide three (3) items of identification, as follows:

- One (1) from Commencement of identity documents
- One (1) from Primary use in the community documents
- One (1) from Secondary use in the community documents
- At least 1 of your 3 documents must include a recent photograph of you
- All identification must be **current** (we cannot accept expired documents, except for an Australian Passport, as outlined below)
- If you provide identity documents in a former name, e.g., maiden name, evidence of the name change is required **in addition** to your identity documents:
 - o Change of name certificate issued by an Australian State or Territory Government
 - Marriage Certificate issued by an Australian State or Territory Government (church or celebrant-issued certificates are not accepted).

Commencement of identity documents

- (a) Australian Birth Certificate or authorised record of birth (not an extract or birth card)
- (b) Current Australian Passport or Australian Passport no more than 3 years expired (but not cancelled)
- (c) Australian Citizenship Certificate
- (d) ImmiCard issued by Department of Home Affairs
- (e) Australian visa (supported by a foreign passport, which is needed for verification) current at the time of entry into Australia as a resident or tourist. Evidence of your visa can be accessed through the Visa Entitlement Verification Online (VEVO) system delivered by the Department of Home Affairs. If you are a New Zealand citizen on a Special Category Visa, you can request your VEVO details from the Department of Home Affairs

Primary use in the community documents

- (a) Current **Australian Passport** (not expired) or Australian Passport no more than 3 years expired (but not cancelled)
- (b) Current Australian driver's licence, learner permit or provisional licence issued by a State or Territory, showing a signature and/or photo
- (c) ImmiCard issued by Department of Home Affairs
- (d) Current foreign passport issued by a country other than Australia with a valid visa or entry stamp
- (e) Current proof of age or photo identity card issued by an Australian Government agency in the name of the applicant, with a signature and photo (this includes a current Working With Children card issued in Western Australia)

Secondary use in the community documents

- (a) Certificate of identity issued by the Department Foreign Affairs and Trade
- (b) Document of identity issued by the Department Foreign Affairs and Trade
- (c) United Nations Convention travel document secondary issued by the Department Foreign Affairs and Trade
- (d) Foreign government issued documents (for example, driver's licence). Documents in languages other than English must be accompanied by a NAATI accredited translation
- (e) Medicare card
- (f) Enrolment with the Australian Electoral Commission
- (g) Security Guard/Crowd Control photo licence
- (h) Evidence of right to an Australian government benefit (Centrelink or Veteran's Affairs)
- (i) Consular photo identity card issued by Department Foreign Affairs and Trade
- (j) Police Force Officer photo identity card
- (k) Australian Defence Force photo identity card

- (I) Commonwealth or state/territory government photo identity card (this may take the form of a working with children or vulnerable people card or a government issued occupational licence)
- (m) Aviation Security Identification Card (ASIC)
- (n) Maritime Security Identity Card (MSIC)
- (o) Firearms licence
- (p) Credit reference check
- (q) Australian secondary or tertiary student photo identity document
- (r) Certified academic transcript issued by an Australian secondary school, TAFE, university or Registered Training Organisation
- (s) Trusted referee's report
- (t) Bank card or credit card issued by an Australian bank, credit union or building society, showing signature
- (u) Evidence of your **Tax File Number** (ATO letter or Notice of Assessment)
