# Music theatre callback information

## Years 7, 9 and 11 entry in 2027

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### What the callback involves

- Dance choreography
- Singing and performance
- Prepared monologue presentation

### What to bring

- A printed copy of the monologue
- A bottle of water

### Adjusted testing conditions

If your child has been approved for adjusted testing conditions, let the sign-in staff know that you have been approved for adjusted conditions and bring a copy of the printed adjusted conditions if not previously provided during the workshop.

### What to wear

Comfortable, form-fitting clothing that is appropriate for free movement. Clothing such as a leotard and tights or leggings/shorts with a form-fitting shirt is suitable. Students must not wear jeans, skirts or dresses. Hair should be tied back, and no jewellery or make-up is to be worn.

### On the test day

Upon arrival to John Curtin College of the Arts, locate and follow the signs to the music theatre registration desk and sign-in your child. If your child has any health conditions that staff should be aware of, please inform the team at this time.

At the scheduled finish time, please return to the registration desk to sign-out and collect your child.

## What happens next

If your child is successful in the callback, they will be invited to an interview at John Curtin College of the Arts which are scheduled to take place during Term 2. You will be contacted directly by the school early in Term 2.

Students who do not progress to the interview stage will be advised before interview invitations are sent.
