## **Dance workshop information Year 7 entry in 2027**

### **What the workshop involves**

- Group ice breakers
- Flexibility exercises
- Creative movement activities

All students will join a movement-based workshop that does not require prior dance training. Callbacks will then be tailored to the dance type preference or the potential identified during the workshop.

### **Essential items to bring to the workshop**

- A printed copy of the completed [Dance - Student questionnaire](#) with your child's photo added.
- A printed copy of the completed [Arts - Student identification form](#) with your child's photo added.
- A printed copy of your child's most recent school report (Semester 2, 2025).
- A bottle of water.

Please note that all forms are non-returnable.

### **Adjusted testing conditions**

If you believe your child may require adjusted testing conditions but have not yet applied, please apply by 12 pm Friday 13 February 2026. For more information on how to apply, visit our [website](#).

### **What to wear**

Comfortable, form-fitting clothing that is appropriate for a dance workshop. Clothing such as a leotard and tights or leggings/shorts with a form-fitting shirt is suitable. Students must not wear jeans, skirts or dresses. Hair should be tied back, and no jewellery or make-up is to be worn. Students take part in the workshop in bare feet.

### **On the test day**

Upon arrival to John Curtin College of the Arts, locate and follow the signs to the dance registration desk, sign-in your child and provide the required forms to the registration staff. If your child has any health conditions that staff should be aware of, please inform the team at this time. At the scheduled finish time, please return to the registration desk to sign-out and collect your child.

## What happens next

If your child is successful in the workshop, they will be invited to a callback. Callbacks are currently scheduled for Sunday 8 March 2026. Further details will be provided when you receive your callback invitation.

Students who do not progress to the callback stage will be advised before callback invitations are sent.
