

GIFTED AND TALENTED DANCE PROGRAM HAMPTON SHS Workshop Information – Entry in 2024

It is important that you read the information below to assist your child in preparation for their Dance workshop.

What the workshop involves

Your child will take part in the following activities to assist in the selection process:

- Group ice breakers;
- Technique and sequencing;
- Flexibility activities; and
- Creative movement.

The workshop is held in an encouraging environment and will hopefully be an enjoyable experience for your child.

What to wear

Please wear comfortable, form-fitting clothing suited to a dance workshop, such as a leotard and tights or tracksuit pants/shorts with a form-fitting shirt. Applicants must not wear jeans, skirts or dresses. Hair is to be tied back and no jewellery or make-up is to be worn. The workshop will be conducted in bare feet.

Essential items to bring to the workshop

- The completed Student Details Form with a passport-sized photo attached.
- The completed Student Health Form
- A photocopy of your child's most recent school report (Semester 2, 2022).
- A bottle of water.

On arrival at the venue, these forms should be handed to the administration staff at the workshop registration table. Any serious health conditions should be brought to the attention of the administration staff at the time of registration. Please note that all forms are non-returnable.

To allow for effective planning of groups, please provide a minimum of three days' notice if you wish to withdraw your child from their session.

The workshop will take approximately two hours. The exact finishing time will be confirmed when you arrive at the venue. All students must be collected promptly and will not be allowed to leave without the escort of a parent/guardian, unless prior permission has been obtained. If you or another parent/guardian are unable to collect your child from their workshop, please contact the Gifted and Talented Unit prior to their session to inform us of who will be collecting them and we will inform the administration staff.

If your child is successful in the workshop, they will be invited to attend an interview with Hampton staff. If you are unable to attend the workshop, please let us know as soon as possible.
