



GIFTED AND TALENTED VISUAL ARTS PROGRAM WORKSHOP INFORMATION SHEET ENTRY 2022

Dear Parents and Gifted and Talented Visual Art Applicants,

Thank you for your interest and application to the Gifted and Talented Visual Art Program. Please see the following information regarding the Visual Art Testing at Applecross SHS.

All Visual Arts testing regardless of an applicant's preference will be held at Applecross SHS.

Students may be assessed on any subject matter within Visual Arts. Please note there is a written component in the workshop. If your child has a diagnosed learning difference, illness or injury that may affect the written task, please contact the Gifted and Talented Selection Unit on (08) 9264 5836 prior to the testing and attach supporting documentation to the Student Health Form.

INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

NOTE: Please see attached Map of Applecross Senior High School.

PARKING: Please park your car and enter off Ardessie Street. There is off street parking available but please **do not park in staff only gated areas**, even briefly, as you may be locked in.

REGISTRATION: Staff will be collecting the completed Student Information Form, including a photo, and the completed Student Health Form. Please ensure these two documents are completed and brought to the workshop, as they are *essential*. Parents/caregivers should contact the Gifted and Talented Unit about any student with a serious medical condition prior to the commencement of the workshop testing.

FOOD/DRINK: Students are required to bring snacks and a water bottle. No canteen facilities will be available. No child will be able to leave the venue during breaks.

MATERIALS & EQUIPMENT: The Art materials used by the students in the Selective Testing process will be supplied by the Department of Education.

HEALTH & SAFETY REQUIREMENTS: Students are required to wear clothing suitable for a Visual Arts workshop, including closed-in shoes, to meet safety requirements. Any serious health conditions should be brought to the attention of the administration staff and the Lead Supervisor at the time of the registration, with supporting documentation attached to the Student Health Form.

PARENT INFORMATION: Please **do not** bring the Applicant's Portfolio or School Report to the Selective Testing. These items may be required at a later date if the candidate is offered an interview at their preferred Visual Arts school/program.

RESULTS: The results of the Selective Testing are forwarded directly to the Gifted and Talented Selection Unit in the Department of Education for processing. No reports on the student's performance in the Visual Arts workshops will be provided, and the artwork produced will be retained by the Department of Education.

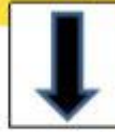
