



GIFTED AND TALENTED DRAMA PROGRAM WORKSHOP INFORMATION SHEET – Year 9, 10 and 11 Entry 2022

It is important that you read the information contained below to assist your child in preparation for their Drama workshop.

Your child will be engaged in a range of activities designed to assist us in our selection process. Drama students participate in the following:

- Group work and problem solving;
- Small group improvisation;
- Monologue presentation (no preparation required, monologue presented at workshop); and
- Individual direction.

Please note there may be a written component and monologue presentation in the workshop. If your child has a diagnosed learning difference that may affect the written task component, please contact the Gifted and Talented Selection Unit prior to the testing.

The session is held in an encouraging environment and all of the activities should be an enjoyable experience.

What to wear

Your child is to wear comfortable, form-fitting clothing suitable for free movement, such as tracksuit pants or shorts with a form-fitting shirt. Applicants must not wear jeans, skirts or dresses. Hair is to be tied back and no jewellery or make-up is to be worn. The workshop will be conducted in bare feet.

Essential items to bring to the workshop

- The completed Student Information Form with a passport-sized photo attached.
- The completed Student Health Form.
- A photocopy of your child's most recent school report (Semester 2, 2020).
- A bottle of water.

Please ensure that the Student Details Form and Student Health Form are completed and brought to the workshop. On arrival at the venue, these forms should be handed to administration staff at the workshop registration table. Any serious health conditions should be brought to the attention of the administration staff at the time of registration. Please note that these forms are non-returnable.

To allow for effective planning of groups, please provide a minimum of three days' notice if you wish to withdraw from the session.

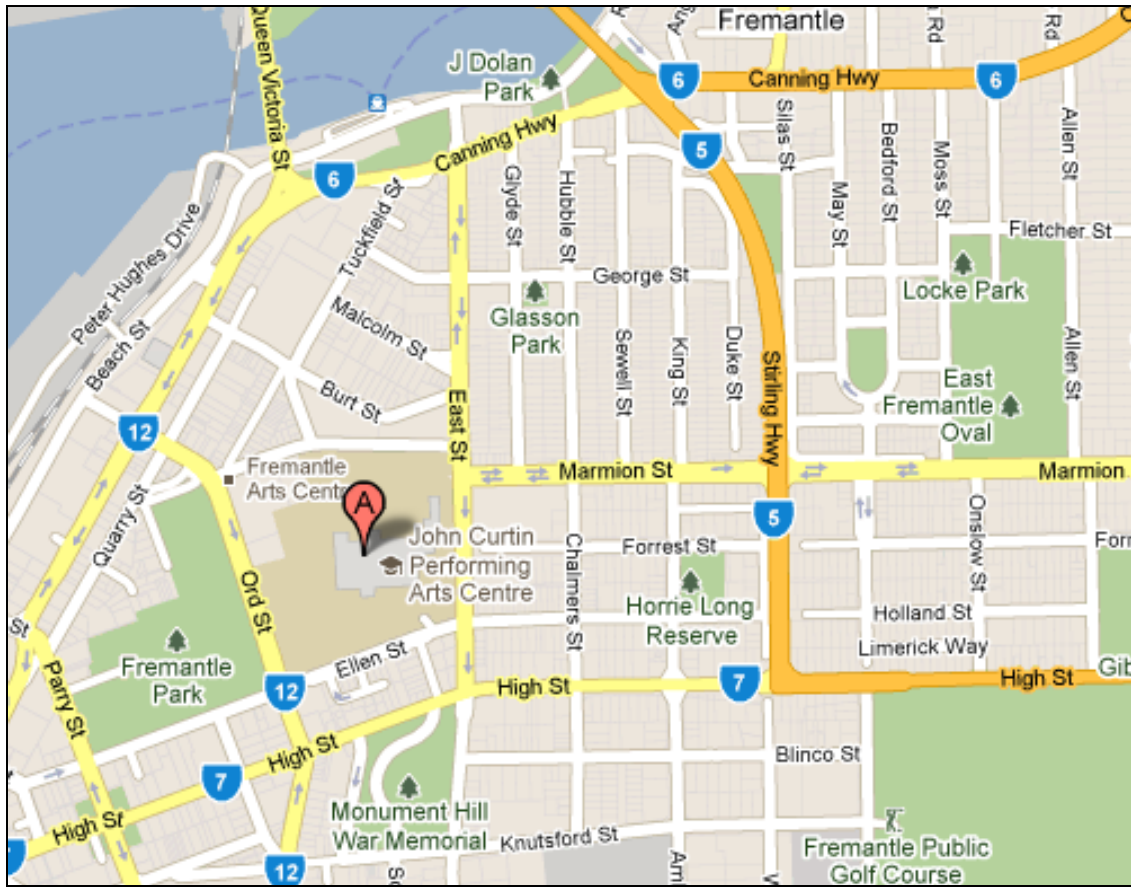
Please allow two hours for the workshop. Exact finishing times will be confirmed on the day. All students must be collected promptly and accompanied by a parent or guardian. Students will not be released without the escort of a parent/guardian, unless prior permission has been obtained.

Call backs:

Should your child be successful in the workshop, you will be notified for a call back for **Saturday 20 March 2021**. All students successful for the Drama call back are required to prepare and memorise the appropriate male or female monologue speech that will be provided when they receive their call back information.
