



Holiday Swimming Lessons

It is important that your children learn to swim.

There are many beaches, rivers, pools and watering holes in Western Australia. They are great for playing, swimming and cooling off when it is hot, but they are not safe if your children cannot swim.

Learning to swim gives your child confidence in the water and the skills to swim safely.

Your children can learn to swim in VacSwim swimming lessons that are offered during the October and summer school holidays.

Children aged 5 to 17 years can take part. There are programs from 5 to 10 days. There are lessons for all abilities, from beginners to good swimmers.

VacSwim lessons are affordable for the whole family and are available at lots of pools and beaches in Perth and in regional areas. Find a location near you on our website.

You need to pay an enrolment fee to enrol your child into a program. If you have three or more children, you can get a discount for your family. You might also need to pay an entry fee at the swimming pool on the day.

You can get a discount if you have one of these concession cards:

- Department of Veterans' Affairs Gold, White or Orange
- Health Care Card
- Out of State Seniors Card
- Pensioner Concession Card
