# What the workshop involves

# **Essential items to bring to the workshop**

- A printed copy of the completed Student questionnaire with your child's photo added.
- A printed copy of the completed Arts Student identification form with your child's photo
- added.
- A printed copy of your child's most recent school report (Semester 2, 2024).
- A bottle of water.
- A printed copy of the adjusted conditions approval email (if applicable).

Please note that all forms are non-returnable.

#### What to wear

Please wear comfortable, form-fitting clothing that is appropriate for a dance workshop. Clothing such as a leotard and tights or leggings/shorts with a form-fitting shirt is suitable. Applicants must not wear jeans, skirts or dresses. Hair should be tied back, and no jewellery or make-up is to be worn.

- Contemporary applicants take part in the workshop in bare feet.
- Ballet applicants will be required to bring and wear their ballet shoes.

## On the test day

Upon arrival to John Curtin College of the Arts, locate and follow the signs to the dance sign-in desk and provide the required forms to the registration staff. Any serious health conditions should be brought to the attention of the staff at this time.

The workshop will run for approximately 2 to 2.5 hours. After the workshop, please return to the registration desk to collect and sign out your child.

# **Adjusted Conditions**


