



Use of visual images of residential college students

IMPORTANT: I understand that while the residential college and Department of Education will only publish my child’s information for the above-stated purposes, the internet is accessible by any person worldwide. I understand that my child’s information can be accessed, copied and used by any other person using the internet (e.g. shared through social media such as Facebook, YouTube, etc.). I understand that once my child’s information has been published on the internet, the residential college and Department of Education have no control over its subsequent use and disclosure. I understand that I can withdraw this permission at any time by contacting the college manager in writing; however, this will not affect materials that have already been published and disseminated.
