# Dance callback information

## Year 7 entry in 2027

### What the callback involves

- Group ice breakers
- Flexibility exercises
- Creative movement activities
- Genre specific technique - contemporary or ballet

If ballet is your first preference, or you were identified as having potential in ballet at the workshop, your callback will be in the ballet genre.

If contemporary is your first preference, or you were identified as having potential in contemporary at the workshop, your callback will be in the contemporary genre.

### What to bring

- A bottle of water

### What to wear

Comfortable, form-fitting clothing that is appropriate for a dance workshop. Clothing such as a leotard and tights or leggings/shorts with a form-fitting shirt is suitable. Students must not wear jeans, skirts or dresses. Hair should be tied back, and no jewellery or make-up is to be worn.

- **Contemporary students** participate in bare feet.
- **Ballet students** bring and wear ballet shoes. If you do not have ballet shoes, socks can be worn.

### On the test day

Upon arrival to John Curtin College of the Arts, locate and follow the signs to the dance registration desk and sign-in your child. If your child has any health conditions that staff should be aware of, please inform the team at this time.

At the scheduled finish time, please return to the registration desk to sign-out and collect your child.

## What happens next

If your child is successful in the callback, they will be invited to an interview at John Curtin College of the Arts which are scheduled to take place during Term 2. You will be contacted directly by the school early in Term 2.

Students who do not progress to the interview stage will be advised before interview invitations are sent.
