What the workshop involves

- Group work and problem solving
- Small group improvisation
- Individual directions
- Prepared monologue presentation

Essential items to bring to the workshop

- A printed copy of the completed [Drama - Student questionnaire](#) with your child's photo added.
- A printed copy of the completed [Arts - Student identification form](#) with your child's photo added.
- A printed copy of your child's most recent school report (Semester 2, 2025).
- A printed copy of the monologue.
- A bottle of water.
- A printed copy of the adjusted conditions approval email (if applicable).

Please note that all forms are non-returnable.

Adjusted testing conditions

If your child has been approved for drama adjusted testing conditions, tick the box on the Student questionnaire and bring a printed copy of your approval email to the workshop. At sign-in, let the registration staff know that your child has been approved for adjusted testing conditions.

What to wear

Comfortable, form-fitting clothing that is appropriate for free movement. Clothing such as tracksuit pants or shorts and a form-fitting shirt is suitable. Students must not wear jeans, skirts or dresses. If preferred, school uniform can be worn as long as it fits within the requirements. Hair should be tied back, and no jewellery or make-up is to be worn. Students take part in the workshop in bare feet.

On the test day

Upon arrival to John Curtin College of the Arts, locate and follow the signs to the drama registration desk, sign-in your child and provide the required forms to the registration staff. If your child has any health conditions that staff should be aware of, please inform the team at this time. At the scheduled finish time, please return to the registration desk to sign-out and collect your child.

What happens next

If your child is successful in the workshop, they will be invited to an interview at John Curtin College of the Arts which are scheduled to take place during Term 2. You will be contacted directly by the school early in Term 2.

Students who do not progress to the interview stage will be advised before interview invitations are sent.
