### Over the counter (OTC) medications

For the safety of all, students are not permitted to keep any medications in their bedrooms. All medications brought to the college must be handed in to staff to be kept secured. Whenever a student requires medication, it must be administered and recorded by college staff.

The residential college has a supply of some over the counter (OTC) medication for use during first aid treatment, or in an emergency. Parents are encouraged to provide all medications their child is likely to need on an 'as needed' basis. OTC medications must be provided in original packaging for staff to administer.

## Medical Consent

In the event of your child needing urgent medical assessment or treatment, staff of Geraldton Residential College will arrange for the appropriate medical care through a local general practice or Geraldton Regional Hospital Emergency Department. Our staff will endeavour to contact you for your consent regarding non-urgent medical care, but in the event of an emergency, or the treatment of a minor condition, we will take necessary action for the welfare of your child. In the instance of a young person being recognised by the treating doctor as a 'mature minor', your child may be able to give their own consent for their medical care.

*If you will require a staff member to attend, and be present, at a medical appointment with your child, please speak with college staff prior to booking to ensure staff availability.*

<b>Emergency Conditions</b>	Injuries or sudden illnesses requiring hospital care	Immediate attendance at hospital
<b>Minor conditions</b>	Minor infections (eg. coughs and colds, gastroenteritis, ear infections) Minor injuries (cuts, bruises, sprains)	Attendance at GP surgery, or hospital <i>if required</i>
<b>Non-urgent conditions</b>	Chronic complaints (eg. hayfever, asthmas, joint pain, headaches, skin conditions) Sexual and reproductive health	Parent consent to be sought prior to GP attendance
