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## CSV DATA FILE SPECIFICATIONS

Data file specifications - unit record data for public and non-government school censuses

Data which may be collected for every student, for: WA School Census (for August and February censuses, as from August 2019)

These data file specifications set out the detailed data which will be collected through the School Censuses. These specifications are intended for the use of software developers to produce a file which will contain the appropriate data, in the appropriate format. This is necessary to enable the School Census System to import the data in a consistent way.

The term "mandatory" means that the data item must be represented in the data file by a valid code or a value within a given range. If a code is outside the range specified, the system will show an error message and the data will not be imported. Note that a code meaning "unknown" or "not stated" is a valid code for many items. For some items, a valid code is not required, and the data file can contain a blank.

The use of the word "mandatory" in the document does not imply that parents are required to provide all information to the school. Questions relating to what information must be provided by parents are addressed in the ACARA Data Standards Manual and in jurisdiction enrolment forms and their explanatory notes.

The data file is to be formatted as a CSV file with column headings exactly as stated in the Data Item column (although it is not case sensitive). The items are to be separated by a comma, with double quotes around all **text** fields (as a minimum). Note it is acceptable to have double quotes around **all** fields. The first row should contain the column headings, as specified by each data item.
