

# **GIFTED AND TALENTED DRAMA PROGRAM**

## **Call Back Information – Entry in 2024**

**It is important that you read the information below to assist your child in preparation for their Drama call back.**

Your child will need to prepare and memorise the monologue that you will receive in your call back information pack.

If your child has a diagnosed condition, learning difference, illness or injury that may affect their performance in the workshop or their ability to recite their monologue, please contact the Gifted and Talented Selection Unit prior to their session and speak to the lead supervisor at sign in. Appropriate documentation to support their condition must be provided, if not already supplied in their workshop.

### **What to wear**

Your child is to wear comfortable, form-fitting clothing that is suitable for free movement, such as tracksuit pants or shorts with a form-fitting shirt. Applicants must not wear jeans, skirts or dresses. Hair is to be tied back and no jewellery or make-up is to be worn. The workshop will be conducted in bare feet.

### **Essential items to bring to the workshop**

- A photocopy of your child's most recent school report (only if you have not already provided this).
- A bottle of water.

**Please contact GTSU if you wish to withdraw your child from their session.**

Parents are responsible for the safe transportation of their child to and from the venue. Parents are required to sign in their child on arrival and sign their child out at the end of the audition/workshop. All students must be collected promptly and will not be allowed to leave without the escort of a parent/guardian, unless prior permission has been obtained. If you or another parent/guardian are unable to collect your child from their workshop, please contact the Gifted and Talented Unit prior to their session to inform us of who will be collecting them and we will inform the administration staff.
