Student experiences of boarding at *Geraldton Residential College* can be enhanced by participating in a range of leisure, recreational, cultural and sporting activities which are a key part of boarding life. Wherever possible, our aim is for your child to take part in the same activities while boarding with us as they would when living at home.

Leisure activities are not connected to the school curriculum and do not include educational excursions arranged by school, or the continuation of school activities by a student after school hours.

These events may be arranged at any time throughout the year, unless specifically indicated. We endeavour to notify parents of all planned leisure activities, but please note that it may not be practical on every occasion for routine recurring activities.

The following information is provided to enable you to make an informed decision as to your child's participation in these various activities.

Our staff 'have a duty of care to protect students from risk of harm that can reasonably be foreseen'. These leisure activities will be assessed for risk prior to commencement and will not proceed if we consider the activity to be 'high' risk. We employ a number of strategies to reduce the likelihood of risks occurring and the consequences should they eventuate. However, it should be noted that engaging in any recreational activity will carry some risk exposure that cannot be eliminated.

	Details:	Students must wear helmets at all times and are encouraged to wear other protective gear such as knee and elbow pads.

	Details:	Staff take students on a short trip to get some fresh air and to kick a ball on the oval.

	Details:	We make regular trips to the beach with supervisors that hold surf rescue qualifications. Students are asked to stay within eyesight of staff. Students may fish from the jetty or beach only – fishing from the rocks is strictly prohibited.

Stages 11 and 12 involve further development of survival and swimming skills and endurance. Stage 12 provides a foundation for rescue awards.
