Dance workshop information

Years 9, 10 and 11 entry in 2027

What the workshop involves

- Group ice breakers
- Flexibility exercises
- Creative movement activities
- Genre specific technique – contemporary or ballet

Essential items to bring to the workshop

- A printed copy of the completed [Dance - Student questionnaire](#) with your child's photo added.
- A printed copy of the completed [Arts - Student identification form](#) with your child's photo added.
- A printed copy of your child's most recent school report (Semester 2, 2025).
- A bottle of water.

Please note that all forms are non-returnable.

What to wear

Comfortable, form-fitting clothing that is appropriate for a dance workshop. Clothing such as a leotard and tights or leggings/shorts with a form-fitting shirt is suitable. Students must not wear jeans, skirts or dresses. Hair should be tied back, and no jewellery or make-up is to be worn.

- **Contemporary students** participate in bare feet.
- **Ballet students** bring and wear ballet shoes. If you do not have ballet shoes, socks can be worn.
 - Students who have been cleared for pointe work and have been training on pointe should bring their pointe shoes

On the test day

Upon arrival to John Curtin College of the Arts, locate and follow the signs to the dance registration desk, sign-in your child and provide the required forms to the registration staff. If your child has any health conditions that staff should be aware of, please inform the team at this time. At the scheduled finish time, please return to the registration desk to sign-out and collect your child.

What happens next

If your child is successful in the workshop, they will be invited to an interview at John Curtin College of the Arts which are scheduled to take place during Term 2. You will be contacted directly by the school early in Term 2.

Students who do not progress to the interview stage will be advised before interview invitations are sent.
