In line with the Department of Education policy, the Geraldton Residential College has implemented the following guidelines:

- Junior Students (Years 7 - 9) must place all their devices into the Technology Cabinet between 8:30pm – 8:45pm (Sunday- Thursday) and before 9:45pm on Friday and Saturday, at the request of the supervisor.
- Devices are returned to students the following morning, once students have achieved room standards.
- No electronic devices will be allowed in the dining room during any meal time. Any student seen on their phone during any meal time will be asked to surrender their phone to staff.

Students in Years 10 - 12 may keep their devices in their rooms (unless requested by parent/guardian to hand them in), however if the technology is missused, parents/guardians will be consulted.

The College accepts no responsibility for replacing lost, stolen or damaged electronic devices.

Gaming Devices (Applies for Years 7-12)

- Gaming Devices are only to be used in the common area.

- Gaming devices **MUST** be surrendered to the Supervisor and placed in the Technology Cabinet before 5:00 pm on Sunday.
- Only the student who brought the device may collect it from the Technology Cabinet. Any other student (inc. siblings) must have the permission of the student who brought it, or parent.
- Personal TV's/Monitors will not be allowed in the student's room, any exceptions are at the discretion of the Supervisory Team.
