



EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT 'IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA

EMERGING TRENDS 2009, 2012, 2015 AND 2018


Western Australia is moving in the right direction with the percentage of children developmentally vulnerable decreasing since 2009.



Twice as many boys were developmentally vulnerable than girls.



Aboriginal children who were developmentally vulnerable has reduced



The gap between Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal children in the percentage of children vulnerable, remains largely unchanged.






