Drama workshop information Year 7 entry in 2026

What the workshop involves

- Group work and problem solving
- Small group improvisation
- Monologue presentation
- Individual directions

Essential items to bring to the workshop

- A printed copy of the completed <u>Student questionnaire</u> with your child's photo added.
- A printed copy of the completed <u>Arts Student identification form</u> with your child's photo added.
- A printed copy of your child's most recent school report (Semester 2, 2024).
- A bottle of water.
- A printed copy of the adjusted conditions approval email (if applicable).

Please note that all forms are non-returnable.

What to wear

Please wear comfortable, form-fitting clothing that is appropriate for free movement. Clothing such as tracksuit pants or shorts and a form-fitting shirt is suitable. Applicants must not wear jeans, skirts or dresses. Hair should be tied back, and no jewellery or make-up is to be worn. Applicants take part in the workshop in bare feet.

On the test day

Upon arrival to John Curtin College of the Arts, locate and follow the signs to the drama sign-in desk and provide the required forms to the registration staff. Any serious health conditions should be brought to the attention of the staff at this time.

The audition will run for approximately two hours. After the audition, please return to the registration desk to collect and sign out your child.

Adjusted Conditions

If your child has been approved for adjusted testing conditions, tick the box on the Student questionnaire and bring a printed copy of your approval email to the workshop. When signing in your child, let the sign-in staff know that you have been approved for adjusted conditions.

If you believe your child may require adjusted testing conditions but have not yet applied, please ensure you apply by 12 pm Monday 17 February 2025. For more information on how to apply, visit our website.


What happens next
